- Cooking/warming equipment/serving utensils
- Plates/bowls/utensils/etc. for your dish
- Canopy for shade (outside of main tent area)
- Ice/propane/extension cords/etc.

What WE supply:

- Approx. 10' x10' "booth" in tented area
- (2) tables with linens per booth
- Sign with chef and dish name
- Access to electricity
- Trash bin at serving tables
